Graphing a Circle. Graphing circles requires two things: the coordinates of the center point, and the radius of a circle. A circle is the set of all points the same distance from a given point, the center of the circle. A radius, r , is the distance from that center point to the circle itself. On a graph, all those points on the circle can be determined and plotted using (x, y) coordinates.

To graph a linear equation, start by making sure the equation is in $y = mx + b$ form. Then, plot the b value on the y -axis. Next, convert the m value into a fraction if it's not already by placing it over 1. Once you've done that, start at the point you plotted on the y -axis, and count up the number that's in the numerator of the fraction.

Cartesian graphs are what mathematicians really mean when they talk about graphs. They compare two sets of numbers, one of which is plotted on the x -axis and one on the y -axis. The numbers can be written as Cartesian coordinates , which look like (x,y) , where x is the number read from the x -axis, and y the number from the y -axis.

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
